MOVIE NIGHT **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

To ensure a safe and fun evening, we ask that you abide by these simple rules:

- **An adult must sign in/out students at the conclusion of the night. Check-in tables will be set up along the hallway of the Commons. Students are NOT to be dropped off! No student will be allowed the leave the building without an adult. We must adhere to the district's liability specifications in order to maintain the privilege of Movie Night.**
- **Your signature will be used for medical release in case of an emergency. Emergency phone numbers given upon check in are mandatory. We must be able to contact you during the movie in the event your child becomes ill or misconduct. There will be zero tolerance for misbehavior.**
- **Students are expected to behave appropriately! Loud talking during the movie, running, throwing food or other items and general misbehaving will not be permitted. We want everyone to have a fun evening. For this to happen we must adhere to the above rules during movie night. **NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES PERMITTED!!****
- **Children are to raise their hands during the movie if they need to use the restroom; a volunteer chaperone will then escort them to the facilities.**

Remember the doors open promptly at 6:30pm. They will not be opened before that time.
