We're "Moving Forward" with our Parking Lot Changes starting Tuesday, April 10th!

After much discussion and research, the Ivy Hill Parking Lot/Traffic Committee has developed ideas for changes to our **morning drop-off (arrival) time**. The parking committee will continue to meet to discuss future new options for pick-up (dismissal) time.

Rules for Morning Drop-Off

1. Pull into the parking lot entrance: Right lane- for student drop-off only
Left lane- for parking only
2. Keep the street/parking lot intersections, sidewalk and crosswalks clear.
3. Pull up along the fire lane slowly in line. Once you enter the line, you must remain in the line until you exit the lot. Students should gather backpacks at this time.
4. Students may only exit cars between the two cones by the fence.
5. Students must exit from the passenger side only. Adults must remain in vehicles.
6. Proceed forward after all students in the drop-off area have exited their cars.
7. Right turn only out of the parking lot.
8. If you are parking in the lot, please pull through to the last lane of parking spots. These are the rows where spots will be available during morning drop off.
9. Please be attentive and follow the guidance of our traffic volunteers!
