Lunchtime at Ivy Hill

The lunch hour is a great time for students to be together, socialize, and play! While eating at school is an option, most children do spend the hour at school enjoying inside time eating and outside time playing.

We want lunchtime to be a positive experience for the students. Children get to choose where they sit during each lunch shift. With approximately 200+ students in the Commons for each shift, it is also important that they are consistently following expectations for the different supervisors each week. Some of the expectations for our lunchroom include: coming prepared with lunch/\$, walking at all times, using polite table manners, listening to adult supervisors the first time, cleaning up after themselves, and enjoying eating and talking with friends.

Last week, we introduced some new routines to reinforce our expectations. Each shift is working to consistently follow expectations so they meet a goal. The first goal is to earn another lunch day with music. If a lunch shift is not meeting expectations consistently in a week, the students also know that they may lose the privilege of choosing their seats for a lunch shift. Assigned seats help us to reinforce specific groups/student as needed. So far, we have not needed to reassign students. We appreciate your support as we want the lunchroom to be a welcoming, safe, and orderly environment for all!
