Illinois Standards Achievement Test (ISAT)

The Illinois Standards Achievement Test (ISAT) measures individual student achievement relative to the Illinois Learning Standards. The results provide parents, teachers, and schools with one measure of student learning and school performance. ISAT testing will begin on March 4th and end March 8th for most of our students at Ivy Hill. Make-up testing will take place the following week.

Students in grades 3 through 8 take the ISAT in reading and mathematics. Students in grades 4 and 7 will also take the ISAT in science. You will receive information about your children's performance on the state tests when the district receives the results at the beginning of the 2013-2014 school year. We will review these results with you, as well as the results from our other district assessments.

We ask for your continued support in preparing your children to be successful on the ISAT. Please be sure your child has plenty of sleep each night and arrives on time for school each day. In addition, a healthy breakfast, snack, and lunch are important for your child. Teachers will share their specific grade level testing schedules with families.
