NWEA MAP Testing-Grades 2-5

Next week, your child will be participating in district-wide Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) achievement testing. Teachers will be notifying families of class testing schedules. It is always important that your children come to school on time having had a good night's sleep and breakfast in the morning. For testing days, it is especially important. Students will take a reading and mathematics assessment. District 25 uses many different measures to chart your child's educational progress. The MAP results assist us in monitoring your child's academic growth and informing curricular and instructional needs. However, the MAP tests only represent one data point in time. We place equal weight on classroom and other assessment data/information gathered throughout the year to help us understand and monitor your child's academic progress during the school year and from year to year.
